Golf & Greens:

I mentioned in this space last month the progress on the construction of the new back tee on number 11. We recently sodded the tee and hope to open it for play within the next 10-14 days. This tee gives us the opportunity to play the hole approximately 20 yards longer than previously.

We recently opened the new back tee on number 4. This new tee plays about 22 yards longer than before and brings the fairway bunkers back into play, as originally designed.

Next week, we intend to start construction of new forward tees on holes 1, 13, and 16. It is my hope that we have the tees nearly completed by the time you view this newsletter next month. Construction of these tees will likely be a challenge considering they are in the line of play and also considering the big uptick in play the last few months. Please watch for our employees and we will do our best to not disrupt play.

When golf architect Andy Staples revised our Master Plan a few years ago, a couple of the main objectives were to not only add length to the course to keep up with improvements/technology in golf equipment, but also to add teeing options to appeal to a wider range of players. All these new teeing areas address this. This added teeing ground also helps us agronomically by giving us more area to spread the wear and tear to allow a little more time for divot recovery.

Overall, we are very happy with course conditions for the first of August. This has been a good summer thus far with average high temperatures and a few opportunistic rains that have helped us save on city water. Hopefully this will continue to be the case.

Please remember to repair ball marks. This is the most critical time of year for the greens and we need all the help we can get to keep them in good shape. I hope to see you on the course.
