Golf & Greens:

Summer is officially here and with it comes the heat and humidity. To combat the elements, it is important for us to do everything we can to give our greens a fighting chance. Air movement across the putting surface is extremely important to the survival of bentgrass in the summer. This air movement allows the plant to use the soil moisture and through a process called transpiration, the plant cools itself. While many of our greens get plenty of air movement naturally, we do have several areas that need assistance from fans. Our club has made a big investment in electrical work and in fans over the last few years to help some of these greens. Last fall we ran about a quarter mile of new wire to supply power for a fan on 2 green. We hope to have this fan up and running in the next week or so.

The maintenance staff will also be venting greens every few weeks throughout the summer. The result of this process leaves small slits in the greens. These slits allow for air and gas exchange in the root zone and have minimal effect on ball roll unlike a conventional aerification.

Of course this is also the time of year you will see our guys hand watering the greens with a hose. We use moisture meters to check the volumetric water content in the root zone and then we will add water to the areas that need it. We realize this is a nuisance at times and do our best not to interrupt play. Sometimes this is unavoidable and it is important to remember that our greens waterers have the right of way on the greens. We appreciate players waiting until we clear the greens before you hit your approach shot. Thank you for your patience on this matter. The good news is that the greens are in great shape heading into the summer months. Our staff has done a good job of preparing them for the heat and humidity that July and August will likely bring.

One last note: the new tees on numbers 6 and 9 are growing in nicely and we anticipate opening them for play next week in advance of the Match Play tournament. The new tee on 6 adds about 22 yards to the hole and the one on number 9 adds 24 yards. We will rotate the gold tees between the current back tees and the new tees.

I look forward to seeing you on the course.

Recorded scores aid the staff in grouping juniors of the same skill level together and will be used for awards.

Chef's Cravings:

I hope everyone is having a great summer! I can't believe it is already July! We have been staying busy with events and the pool! We are looking forward to the festivities on July 4th and of course the 4 Ball Invitational at the end of July!

I thought I would share another one of my favorite recipes this month. Homemade Tater Tots, a delicious creation, and who doesn't like tater tots!

Homemade Tater Tots

First, you will need the following ingredients:

4 Russet Potatoes

Flour

- 1 Tbsp Salt
- 2 Tsp Pepper
- 1 Tsp Garlic Powder
- 1 Tbsp Parsley (Optional)

Boil your potatoes until they are almost done, but still a bit undercooked. Let them cool. Then grate them with a hand grater or mechanical if you have that. Use the bigger shredding holes for this so you have the real feel of a tot.

After the potatoes are grated, spread them out and season with salt, pepper, garlic & parsley and a little flour. Try to season as evenly as possible. Lightly mix together, but do not over mix or the potatoes will become gummy. After they are mixed, form them in to tater tot shapes.

Pre-heat your fryer or oil in a pan to 350 degrees. Fry for about 3-4 minutes. Let cool & enjoy!
