What services will be offered at the Pool?

There will be Food & Beverage service at the pool house. Food will be served on the upper patio as food is not allowed on the pool deck.

What are the guest fees for the pool?

There is a \$6 non-member fee for swimmers.

Are beverages served on the Golf Course?

Yes. The beverage cart is available Friday, Saturday & Sunday 10:00am-7:00pm.

Are guests allowed on the Golf Course?

Yes. Each guest is limited to six 18 hole rounds per year. Guests are charged a guest fee and applicable taxes.

Are reservations required in the dining room?

In order to staff properly, reservations are always recommended, however not required.

Parties of 12 or more must go through Kristie so they may be booked in an available banquet room.

What is the dress code for the dining room?

No swimsuits/cover-ups. Shoes must be worn at all times. No torn or ripped jeans.

Notes from the Pro:

We are off to a great start this season with a couple tournaments in our rearview and some big tournaments on the horizon.

Match Play Qualifying starts June 1st, please stop by the Golf Shop before you qualify and let us know that you are playing so that we can write you down.

The Women's Eclectic tournament will be on June 4th and 5th. Registration is open on the website as well as a signup sheet in the Women's Locker Room. Please call the Golf Shop if you have any questions. Players will be going off each day with Tee Times starting at 8:30AM.

The Member Guest will be June 7th, 8th and 9th. Registration is open on the website as well as the Golf Shop. The first round of the Member Guest will start with a 12:00PM Shotgun on Friday, June 7th. The golf course will be closed in the morning so that Brandon and the maintenance crew can prepare the course.

The Tyson Golf Event will be on Thursday, June 13th and will start at 9:00AM with a shotgun start. The course will be closed in the morning and will reopen after the event.

The Parent Child Tournament will be on June 16th. Registration is open on the website under Mixed Events. Tee Times will be all day, just call the golf shop to set up a time.

Our first Junior Golf Camp is on June 17th – June 21st. Registration is open on the website. The price for the camp is \$150 and you will need to pay with cash or a check made out to "Fayetteville Junior Golf".

We have started our PGA Jr. League season and have 43 total players in the program up from 16 last year. Our first match was May 22nd at Shadow Valley. On June 1st both of our PGA Jr. League teams have a match against Pinnacle CC and Springdale CC. Both matches will be on the front nine of our course and Members will not be able to go off of number one after 2:00PM.

Please remember as the days get longer the Driving Range will stay open later but we will be closing the range one hour before sunset. That will allow our staff time to pick the range and have things ready for the next morning. On Wednesday and Sunday evenings we will be closing the Driving Range at 6:30 so that our staff can clean pick the range. Also, the golf course is CLOSED on Mondays. This includes the golf course, driving range, putting green and chipping greens. We are closed to allow the maintenance staff time to prepare the course for the membership for that coming week.

Golf & Greens:

We have been fortunate here at the club to avoid much of the wrath Mother Nature has been dealing out to many of our neighbors. Aside from some wind damage on May 18th, we have only had to deal with some wetter than normal course conditions. However, it has made it extremely difficult to get topsoil to finish up the new tee construction and for backfilling around the new cart paths. It seems like every time it almost gets dry enough for our topsoil providers to sift the topsoil, it rains again. We finally received a few loads this week (about ¼ of what we need), and we are going to be able to fill the areas on 13 and 16 where we relocated the cart paths. Now our problem is getting sod to place on these areas. All of our sod comes from farms located either in the Bixby OK area or near Spiro Ok. Both of these areas are currently under water from the catastrophic Arkansas River flooding. There is a chance we will receive some sod early next week if it stays dry for a few days. Our fingers are crossed. Please bear with us as we tie up these loose ends.

It's a big week at the golf course maintenance shop as we are taking delivery of two new John Deere fairway mowers and in a couple of weeks we will be receiving a new sprayer. This is a tremendous upgrade to our fleet. It will make our operation more efficient, cut down on repair costs and down time and should result in better playing conditions, which is our ultimate goal.

We are fully staffed with our seasonal employees. We have a really good group this year. Several of them have worked with us in the past and we are excited to have them here.

I am also excited with how the course is rounding into shape. We expect course conditions to be very good for next week's Member-Guest. If you have not signed up to play yet, I would encourage you to do so. It will be a great event.

I hope to see you on the course soon.

This group will not include your child. After completing each round, a scorekeeper will be required to turn in his/her scorecard to the pro shop. Recorded scores aid the staff in grouping juniors of the same skill level together and will be used for awards.

Chef's Cravings:

This month I would like to share a recipe for one of my favorite snacks. Quick and easy, Honey Roasted Cashews. Here is what you will need:

4 Cups of Cashews

2 ½ TBSP Honey

1 TBSP Butter

¼ Cup Sugar

Salt

First, measure out your cashews. Microwave the honey and the butter together for about 45 seconds, making sure it is warm and pliable. Toss the cashews in a bowl with the honey and butter mixture, evenly coating them all, and lay them out on a baking sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for 5 minutes. Take out, toss the cashews and put back in the oven for about 2 more minutes or until they are nice and golden. Brown isn't bad but the flavor changes a lot the darker the cashews get. Once they are golden brown, take them out and immediately toss them in a bowl with the sugar and your preferred amount of salt. Stick them in the refrigerator or freezer to cool. Once they are cooled, put them in your favorite snack dish or just eat them off the pan if you can't wait. Be careful because you won't be able to stop eating them!
