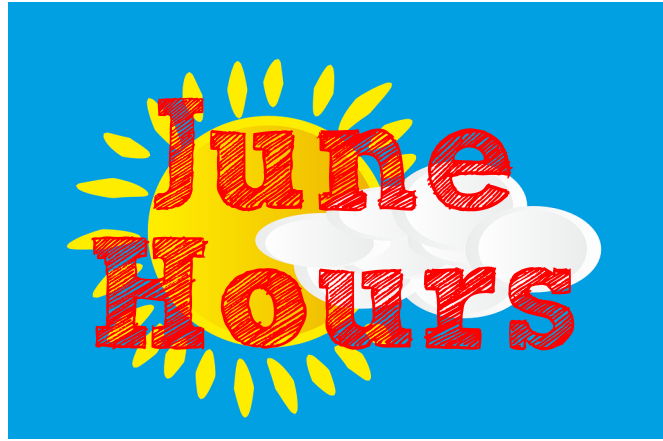

## *Golf & Greens:*

It has been a little while since our last newsletter article, so we wanted to provide a quick update on what's been going on with the golf maintenance team. It's been a busy couple of months for us, in spite of everything that has been going on.

We have been able to complete a little more than a mile of cart path renovation this spring. This is in addition to the approximately 1.2 miles we replaced last spring. This project has really made a tremendous impact on our golf course. Not just from having a smoother ride, but the new paths give a much cleaner look. It really makes the ones we haven't renovated stand out. I cannot overstate how thankful we are to Dennis Tune and Tune Concrete for all the help with this project. We would not have been able to do half of what we have done without him. Additionally, Matt Britt has provided an excavator for the work all winter and spring. Thank you all for your help in making an improvement that will be enjoyed by our members for decades.

If you have been to the club in the last few weeks, you've undoubtedly noticed the big bare area between the clubhouse and number 9 green. In an effort to improve the view of 9 green from the new back patio, we removed the large mound that was there prior. We took the soil from the mound to construct a new back tee on number 4. Repurposing this soil saved the club approximately \$3000. This new tee will add about 22 yards to the hole and bring the fairway bunkers back into play for some of the longer hitters. The recent rains have made it terribly difficult to get topsoil and sod, but as soon as it dries up some, we should be able to complete the job. We hope to have the tee open before our Match Play event.

A big "Thank You" goes out to Anne Butt, Vicki Parker and Sylvia Schlegel for all their work on our flower beds and landscaping. They spent all day a few Mondays back planting annuals and perennials, trimming plants and cleaning up. I know they also had help from Stan and Linda Salmonson and maybe some others I missed. Thank you all for your hard work and dedication to the improvement of the overall appearance and presentation of our club.

We have been happy to see so many of you using the club as a source of escape from the grips of this pandemic and I hope that continues as life inches back toward normalcy. We will see you on the course!
