

We've built two new patios behind the clubhouse with a truly fantastic view of both 9 and 18 greens, the surrounding mountains and amazing sunsets. I think you'll find the furniture inviting and comfortable with cushioned seating arranged in groups; one of which around a beautiful fire table.

The seating makes for a comfortable spot to enjoy a beverage and conversation and as such, we will serve cocktails on the patio Friday and Saturday evenings starting in Mid-May when we've engaged our Summer Staff. However, since we always serve the existing dining patio, we will try to keep an eye on the area at other times as well but on both those nights, that's the place to be!! With the soft seating, we ask that everyone refrain from smoking.

FCC has purchased beautiful new furniture for the pool deck, pool dining deck, and all of the outdoor patios.


At the pool, we are changing the operation a bit to allow more space in the shade for kids to play games and get a break from the heat. As such, the 'bar' that we've had there in the past will now serve canned items (beer, soft drinks, Gatorade, etc.) with all other items coming from the clubhouse. Compared to years past, the key difference is that instead of coming to you for your order, you will order at the gate; this way, the personnel that concentrated on taking orders will now be utilized to transfer food and beverage from the clubhouse to the pool. When things are slow, we will encourage the staff to walk the deck for orders.

Another change this year is one of policy that required clarification. <u>Grandchildren of members</u> that are under 23 years of age are still treated as a Member in that there is no Guest fee. However, just like at the Golf Shop, they must be accompanied by the Member.

For those who REALLY haven't been here in awhile, Kiana left in January to take a position with P&G and just recently, Peter left for Pinnacle CC. I have hired Cassandra Center as Food & Beverage Director and Emilee Hammond as Assistant. Cassandra has been here a few weeks and Emilee starts in Mid-May after graduation. I'm confident they will be a welcome addition to the team!

What services will be offered at the Pool?

There will be Food & Beverage service at the pool house. Food will be served on the upper patio as food is not allowed on the pool deck.

What are the guest fees for the pool?

There is a \$6 non-member fee for swimmers.

Do you offer swim lessons?

Are beverages served on the Golf Course?

Yes. The beverage cart is available Friday, Saturday & Sunday 9:00am-7:00pm.

Are guests allowed on the Golf Course?

Yes. Each guest is limited to six 18 hole rounds per year. Guests are charged a guest fee and applicable taxes.

Are reservations required in the dining room?

In order to staff properly, reservations are always recommended, however not required.

Parties of 12 or more must go through Kristie so they may be booked in an available banquet room.

What is the dress code for the dining room?

No swimsuits/cover-ups. Shoes must be worn at all times. No torn or ripped jeans.

Golf & Greens:

It's been a busy April for the course maintenance department. Between rain events, we managed to remove the old asphalt/concrete on most of number 13 cart path. We also rerouted a stretch of the path there to present a better look from the tee box. This allowed Tony Blackston's crew to form and finish 1000 linear feet of new cart on number 13.

We also were involved with the construction of the new back patio of the clubhouse. A substantial amount of dirt had to be cored out to make way for the sub base and concrete in this area. Tony's crew did a great job here as well. A special thanks to Dennis Tune for all his help with these improvements. This new area is going to be a tremendous addition to the club and we are glad to be a part of it.

We were actually able to use the dirt from the patio area to go toward the construction of new back tees for number 6 and 9. The new tee on 6 will add approximately 20 yards and the new tee on 9 around 25 yards. The next tee we plan to construct will be a back tee on number 2. It will add around 22 yards and will have a little different line of play than the current tees. The new tee will shift back to the west from the current tees. We expect this new tee to make number 2 a more challenging hole for the longer hitters.

We are excited about these changes and the improvements they will bring. I hope to see you on the course soon.
