


# Yoga

#### Meet your instructor Morgan L Brown:

Yoga has been a wonderful part of my life for almost 7 years. It allows me to create a space for mindfulness and relaxation while connecting to movements within the body. Growing up in southwest Arkansas, yoga was not a big part of my life until college. I found it while searching for an exercise that could help with my anxiety and joint pain. Once I tried yoga, I quickly realized I had to share this experience with others. I completed my 200 hour yoga training at Yoga Deza in spring of 2016. My favorite styles of classes to teach are vinyasa and yin yoga. Vinyasa is a flowing sequence of poses that involves connecting the breath to each movement. Yin yoga is a slower pace style of yoga that allows you to find a deeper stretch while holding the poses for longer periods of time. I enjoy learning each of my students individual needs to better suit their yoga practice. Combining creative sequencing with a bit of playfulness, my students grow stronger, more flexible, and relaxed both on and off the mat.

## GOLF & GREENS

#### Golf & Greens:

Last week, fall officially began. And while it hasn't exactly felt like autumn lately, the golf course maintenance staff has been busy preparing for the colder months.

Our first order of business was last month's green aerification. Ideal weather and growing conditions led to a rapid recovery of the greens and they were back to normal in only a couple of weeks. It has been a really good year for growing bentgrass greens in our region.

Two weeks ago, we started applying our fall pre-emergent application for the prevention of winter weeds on fairways, tees and around greens. This application is applied with a fertilizer high in potassium. Potassium is important for preparing the bermudagrass for the winter months providing some defense against winter injury. We will continue applying potassium through the next 4-6 weeks on fairways, tees and around greens.

This is also the time of year we raise the heights of cut on fairways, tees and greens surrounds. We mow these areas at approximately a ½ inch mowing height throughout most of the growing season. However, in September, we begin gradually raising the height to just over ¾ inch by late October. Considering we usually experience around 5 months of dormancy in northwest Arkansas, this extra canopy is important for providing protection for the bermudagrass against traffic and winter injury.

With approximately 1500 trees on the property, leaf removal is a big task this time of year. The dry spell we are currently experiencing has started the leaf drop a little earlier than normal. This will be a constant battle for the next 6 weeks or so, but we will do our best to keep the course as clean as possible so you can enjoy, what I believe is, the best time of year to play golf. I hope to see you on the golf course soon.
