## **Golf & Greens:**

After some timely rains and little cool down, the golf course is really rounding into form. Following the extremely warm May, June and most of July, a mild finish to the summer would certainly be welcomed. The approximately 2.5" of rain we received could not have come at a better time. It not only hydrated many areas that we cannot irrigate, but also likely saved the club thousands in city water bills because our well was not keeping up with demand. The rain allowed us to turn off irrigation and let the well refill the irrigation pond. Additionally, we dodged the storm damage that affected many people in our area.

Two weeks ago, we verticut and topdressed our tees. I had some questions about why we would tear up the tees this time of year. The answer is that the tees have to be dethatched periodically to prevent them from becoming too soft and spongy. This leads to scalping and poor playing conditions. It is similar to the reasons we aerify and topdress greens. The reason for timing it like we did was that we need to do it when the grass is actively growing so that it recovers quickly. This was also a time when we had a little break in the tournament schedule. I hope this clears up any questions you may have had about this maintenance practice.

It is approaching the time of year when some of our seasonal staff gets ready to start back to school. I thought it would be appropriate to recognize them in this space for all their hard work this summer. Owen Moore, Brace Collier, Jack Parmele, Matt Cantrell and Mitchell Cantrell have done a great job for us this summer and we will miss them. If you see them on the course, give them a pat on the back. Thanks again guys and good luck this fall in school.

Weekend and holiday mornings can be really busy on the golf course in the summer. Often times there is a line at the first tee waiting to go off. Naturally, some players want to go to another area of the course that is "open" so they can get their round started. The maintenance staff works generally in order (numerically) in an effort to stay ahead of play so that the course is properly prepared for the day. When players begin their round on number 10 or any other random starting point, it becomes impossible for us to stay ahead, regardless of when we start. When our workers get caught by play, oftentimes it can take an hour or longer than it should to finish our jobs. For this reason, we are asking that all players begin their round on hole number 1 when possible and it is now a **requirement on weekend mornings**. Thank you all for your understanding on this matter.
