GOLF & GREENS

Golf & Greens:

The golf course maintenance department has been busy since the start of the new year tackling the removal and replacement of many of our cart paths that were in poor condition. If you have been on the course, you will have noticed that most of number 1 cart path has been removed and a little more than half has been replaced. Also, most of number 5 path and about half of number 8 have been removed. The remainder of number 1 and number 5 are formed and ready to pour as soon as the weather cooperates. After number 8 is finished, we plan to move to number 16, where we will have to replace nearly everything after the path crosses the pond. From there, we will go to number 13 and then to number 4 after that.

This project should allow for replacement of approximately 6000 linear feet of 6 feet wide cart path. That is close to 1/3 of all our paths. While it will not be enough to replace all the asphalt sections of our paths, it will cover a vast majority of them. The weather will be a big factor in how much of the project we will be able to complete this spring. We got out to a fast start, but the recent cold and rainy weather has held us up the last two weeks. It should move along pretty quickly if we can get an extended period of little to no precipitation and temperatures above freezing. Unfortunately, that is the kind of weather everybody that plays golf is looking forward to. It will be likely that a hole or two may be temporarily closed or altered to allow us to work on the paths during the next couple months. Thank you for your patience.

I would be remiss not to mention Dennis Tune and Tune Concrete for his generosity and help with this project. Without him, we would probably be replacing less than half the paths than we will now.

I will keep you updated on our progress in this column. Hopefully, next month I am reporting how we have made great strides toward completion. I hope to see you on the course soon.
