- All lines must be filled out completely except address, or the entry is void.
- All teams with a FCC member will be accepted upon receipt of a complete entry.
- All teams without a FCC member will be received when the check/cash to Jason Carter is received...you may still email/fax your entry to help get on the spreadsheet while "check is in the mail". Be sure to include a hard copy of your completed entry with funds.
- All teams with a FCC member are also welcome to pay with cash/check in advance. If you have a non-member on your team, you will be billed the entire amount. Teams comprised of two FCC members can be split on their billing.
- The grace period for members and non-member players who played the previous year to guarantee their spot is:

8:00AM July 2nd so get your entries in ASAP!!

The priority/hierarchy for entry is:

- 1) All levels of FCC Members that are not currently suspended
- 2) Players that played and behaved last year
- 3) Open entries

This is all pointless after **8AM on July 2nd** when it opens to everybody.

***An email confirmation will be sent upon receipt of your entry.

***Teams with 1 FCC member and a non-member will be billed entirely to the members account. Please arrange with your partner in this instance to compensate him your half.

***Teams with 2 FCC members will be split.

***Players 65 years of age and older will play white tees (this is a new rule).

Golf & Greens:

Summer is here and with it comes the heat and humidity. After last year's incredibly mild summer, it looks like this one is going to be a long one. To combat the elements, it is important for us to do everything we can to give our greens a fighting chance. Air movement across the putting surface is extremely important to the survival of bentgrass in the summer. This air movement allows the plant to use the soil moisture and through a process called transpiration, the plant cools itself. While many of our greens get plenty of air movement naturally, we do have several areas that need assistance with fans. Our club has made a big investment in electrical work and in fans over the last few years to help some of these greens. Recently, the board approved funding to run electrical service to number 2 green so that we can add a fan there. While much of this investment is in work that is not "visible", it is critical in helping the greens survive. The way this summer is shaping up, we will likely need all the help we can get.

The maintenance staff will also be venting greens every few weeks throughout the summer. The result of this process leaves small slits in the greens. These slits allow for air and gas exchange in the root zone and have minimal effect on ball roll unlike a conventional aerification.

Of course this is also the time of year you will see our guys hand watering the greens with a hose. We use moisture meters to check the volumetric water content in the root zone and then we will add water to the areas that need it. We realize this is a nuisance at times and do our best not to interrupt play. Sometimes this is unavoidable and it is important to remember that our greens waterers have the right of way on the greens. We appreciate players waiting until we clear the greens before you hit your approach shot. Thank you for your patience on this matter. The good news is that the greens are in great shape heading into the summer months. Our staff has done a good job of preparing them for the heat and humidity that July and August will likely bring.

One last note: the new tee on number 14 is growing in nicely and we anticipate opening it for play next week in advance of the Match Play tournament. This new tee adds about 30 yards to number 14 and gives a little different angle to the hole. We will rotate the gold tees between the current back tee and the new tee but we hope this new tee adds some interest to the hole.

I look forward to seeing you on the course.

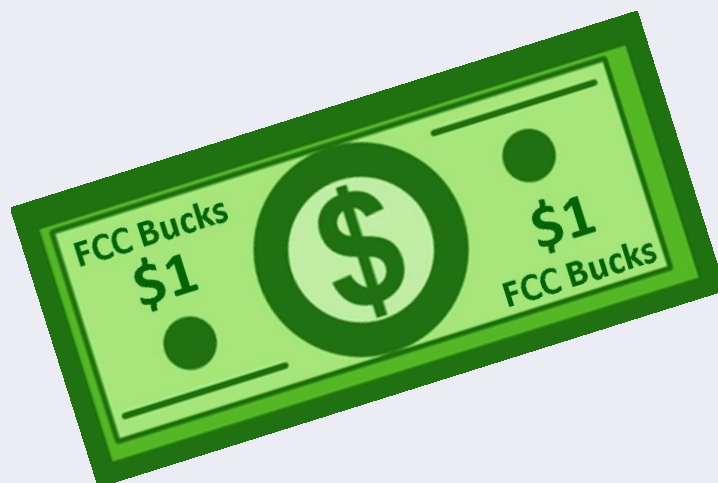
