Can you believe it's already May? It feels like just yesterday we were all in the quarantine era and only doing to go orders and now we are back in full swing, time flies. Speaking of that, I will be celebrating 6 years here at FCC on May 23! I am forever thankful for the opportunity I was given here, everybody needs their big start somewhere and mine was here.

You might have noticed the new menu is out! I added a few new items, and went with a honey garlic salmon. I also have Szechuan peppercorns that I want to start using for a few asian dishes/marinades. One of the cool things about the Szechuan peppercorns, is that they cause a numbing or tingling sensation on your tongue. They add a nice uniqueness to the flavor. The menu seems to be selling pretty well, but I might change up the Tamarind shrimp.
